§ 43-1. Open containers and public consumption.

No person shall drink or consume an alcoholic beverage or possess an open container of such beverage with the intent to consume it in public on any public street, public sidewalk or public parking area within the Town of Vernon, outside the City of Sherrill and the Villages of Vernon and Oneida Castle.

§ 43-2. Penalties for offenses.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be punishable by a fine not exceeding two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.) for each offense or by imprisonment for a term not to exceed fifteen (15) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
